## Movement of Natural Persons

The Movement of Natural Persons Chapter aims to make it easier for business people and skilled or semi-skilled workers from one PACER Plus country to gain temporary entry into another PACER Plus country.

The commitments on business people were negotiated to make it easier for businesses to invest or provide services in the Pacific. It can be difficult for a business to do this if their management or staff cannot visit the country they wish to enter. For example, they may want to check up on their operations or supervise the setting up of a new office.
